



The Goddard School + Little Miami = Kid Village All-Day Kindergarten

Frequently Asked Questions

Is my child required to attend Kid Village 5 days per week?

No, you have the flexibility to set the schedule as to which days you would like your child to attend Kid Village. You only pay for the days your child attends.

Hours: When does Kid Village operate?

Kid Village operates on the same schedule as the Little Miami School District. Start and end times, delayed start days and school closings are the same.

Transportation: Can my child still ride the bus to and from school?

Yes, Little Miami students may be transported to and from school in the morning and mid-day. Students must be picked up as car riders in the afternoon from the Kings Point Church of God.

Lunch: When does my child eat lunch? Can my child buy a school lunch?

All Kid Village kindergarten students must pack a lunch and will eat at the Kings Point Church of God.

What will my child learn at Kid Village?

Kid Village is designed to reinforce Little Miami Kindergarten objectives. Kid Village consists of Language Arts, Math, Writer's Workshop, Science, Daily 6 (learning stations), Art, Music and Sign Language. We offer low child/teacher ratios, consistency in education and affordable tuition.

Is it too late to enroll?

No, it is never too late to get started. We enroll students throughout the entire school year.
